The Rivne Cultural Development Strategy until the 2030s was developed as part of the project "Rivne Cultural Development Strategy", which was funded by the European Union within the EU4Culture programme (the total cost of the project is EUR 30,000).

On June 29, 2021, the Agreement on cooperation in the field of gastronomic tourism was signed between Lublin and the Rivne City Territorial Community.





In 2020, the city of Rivne was awarded the Honorary Flag, which is the second level in the system of awards of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe.



The imperative advantage of the Territorial Community is the location at the intersection of three international highways.


The E40 International Motorway is the longest European highway of 8 500 km, connecting the French city of Calais through Belgium, Germany, Poland, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan and Kyrgyzstan to the Kazakh city of Ridder near the border with China.

European route E373 is a European highway (590 km) passing through the territory of Ukraine and Poland. The route runs from Kyiv through Korosten, Sarny, Kovel, the international checkpoint Yahodyn - Dorohusk, Chełm, Piaski to Lublin.

The European route E85 is a European highway that originates in Klaipėda, Lithuania and ends in Alexandroupoli, Greece. The total length is 2 300 km.

On **July 26, 2012**, Rivne has joined the EU Covenant of Mayors initiative, which entails a voluntary commitment by cities and towns to go beyond the objectives of the EU energy policy by achieving at least a 20% reduction of greenhouse emissions by 2020 through sustainable energy and climate protection actions.

The cooperation of Rivne with the Nordic Environment Finance Corporation (NEFCO) began in June 2015.

The city has successfully implemented of NEFCO-1 project "Implementation of Energy Saving in Three Schools and Energy Management System at Rivne Budget Establishments" (school No. 18 and 27) and of NEFCO-2 project "Implementation of Energy Saving in Rivne Educational Establishment" (secondary school No. 26).

On November 8, 2022, a grant agreement was signed within the framework of the project «Reconstruction and restoration of the municipal infrastructure of the city of Rivne to support the urgent needs of internally displaced persons» in the amount of EUR 1.56 million.

The project envisages comprehensive thermal renovation of two buildings with the aim of improving the living conditions of children with special needs, including children of displaced persons.

The project is implemented with the financial support of the European Union, with the participation of NEFCO, as an executive organization, within the NIP Program "EU Support to Urgent Housing Needs for Internally Displaced Persons in Ukraine" under the NIP.



The implementation of the project "Investments in the energy efficiency of budget buildings and street lighting in the city of Rivne" in the amount of EUR 1.2 million (financed by the "NORWAY-UKRAINE ENERGY EFFICIENCY INITIATIVE" NUEE fund) is coming to an end.

Within the project, thermal modernization is being implemented in three preschool education institutions (No. 46, No. 33, No. 14) and the installation of individual heating points in 8 institutions of the communal sphere of the Rivne City Territorial Community.

The project "Cultural heritage of the kitchen - promotion of culinary traditions through the professionalization of the gastronomic offer of Lublin and Rivne", was implementation within the Cross-Border Cooperation Programme Poland-Belarus-Ukraine 2014 – 2020 under the European Neighbourhood Instrument.

The total cost of the project is EUR 65.8 thousand.













investment proposals for cooperation

- an industrial park for the cultivation and processing of Cannabis, with an area of land of 9,000 hectares, for plastic, clothing for the military, food products, etc.;
- development of exhibition activities. The city of Rivne can offer several interesting investment sites for this, for example construction of: a modern expo center, high-class hotels, entertainment complexes, congress centers;
- creation of industrial parks, which will be located on the land plots of the territorial community (separate land plots have already been actually prepared for the investor);
- construction of the so-called dry port a large logistics hub, the goods of which will be transported by rail. After all, the transportation of goods by rail is much cheaper than by road transport and will help to reduce the load on roads. Therefore, the creation of a «dry port» will significantly contribute to the development of export-import relations of the territorial community with EU countries;
- airport recovery. The Rivne City Territorial Community has an airport that is designed to receive, maintain and send all types of aircraft with a take-off weight of up to 210 tons. The total area of the airport is 165 hectares. Runway 2626 m x 42 m. Maximum throughput 500 passengers/hour, freight transport 50 t/day. The airport is located at the intersection of international airline and road routes, in close proximity (1 km) to the E40 international motorway the longest European highway of 8,500 km.
