

historical facts





Rivne is a great city, one of the largest cities in Western Ukraine, with over 700 years of history. Volodymyr Vasyliovych, the prince of Volhynia and the nephew of the well-known Daniel of Galicia (Danylo Halytsky) built Rivne on the eastern borders of his principality. From 1200 to 1340, the territory of the city belonged to the Kingdom of Galicia–Volhynia. After the partition of this kingdom in 1340, the territory of the present city belonged to the Grand Duchy of Lithuania. Since 1350s Rivne it was under the rule of Great Duchy of Lithuania.

Since 1461, the city belonged to Prince Semen Nesvizh (Semen Vasyliovych Nesvitskyi), the representative of the Rus'ian and Lithuanian dynasty Gediminovich. Since 1479, the city was passed to his wife Maria who became known as the Princess of Rivne. From 1518 to 1621 the city belonged to the Princes of Ostrog.

During World War I, it was a frontline city for a long time. From September 1920 the city was a district centre of Polish Volhynian Voivodeship. In December 1939, Rivne became the centre of the newly established Rivne Oblast, within the Ukrainian SSR.

In the 1960s and 1980s, the city faced the period of intensive growth and development. It was a dramatic change of the overall look of Rivne: there appeared new residential areas in the city centre, new neighbourhoods and new powerful companies. The population of Rivne also grew significantly.

In the late 1980s, when the top management of the Soviet Union introduced new domestic policy within the framework of so-called «Perestroika» and truly relaxed some of the existing restrictions, Rivne finally faced the revival of the national liberation movement. At this time Rivne inhabitants created the first branches of the Taras Shevchenko Ukrainian Language Society and the People's Movement of Ukraine.

On June 16, 1990, when for the first time in years the public of Ukraine in general and Rivne Oblast (region) in particular openly and solemnly celebrated the anniversary of the Battle of Berestechko, the yellow-and-blue flag was flown over an official governmental building of the City Council. The opening of the City Council sessions started with the state anthem «Shche ne vmerla Ukraina», a long before its music was officially adopted.

On May 22, 1999, the Taras Shevchenko Monument was unveiled on maidan Nezalezhnosti (Independence Square). The square and monument to Maria Nesvytska, the local Princess and the founder of the city of Rivne became the real gem and the recreation spot for both Rivne residents and the city guests.

Rivne is the administrative, economic and cultural centre of Rivne Oblast (region). It is an excellent strategically located city with a great business climate, all required infrastructure for successful business, and a decent quality of life. The city also enjoys rich and diverse cultural life as it partners with art events, festivals and concerts all-year round.

The first recorded mention of Kvasyliv dates back to 1445. Throughout its history, from the moment when the town was established, Kvasyliv has been the centre of both political and public life in Volhynia. Josef Perny was the main initiator of the founding of Kvasyliv.

In 1873, Czech brewer Josef Zeman moved with his family to Kvasyliv and began the construction of the local brewery. The brewery provided beer to Rivne, Kvasyliv and nearby villages. They produced only draught beer (also called spelt draft). After the war, the enterprise was reconstructed and its capacity increased fivefold. In 1885, the community built a new Orthodox church, which later became a cathedral. Kvasyliv acquired the status of an urban-type settlement in 1978.

In 2020, the city of Rivne was awarded the **Honorary Flag**, which is the second level in the system of awards of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe.







The imperative advantage of the Territorial Community is the location at the intersection of three international highways.

The E40 International Motorway is the longest European highway of 8 500 km, connecting the French city of Calais through Belgium, Germany, Poland, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan and Kyrgyzstan to the Kazakh city of Ridder near the border with China. **European route E373** is a European highway (590 km) passing through the territory of Ukraine and Poland. The route runs from Kyiv through Korosten, Sarny, Kovel, the international checkpoint Yahodyn - Dorohusk, Chełm, Piaski to Lublin.

The European route E85 is a European highway that originates in Klaipėda, Lithuania and ends in Alexandroupoli, Greece. The total length is 2 300 km.




population pyramid of the city of Rivne



The cooperation of Rivne with the Nordic Environment Finance Corporation (NEFCO) began in June 2015

The city has successfully implemented of NEFCO-1 project «Implementation of Energy Saving in Three Schools and Energy Management System at Rivne Budget Establishments» (school No. 18 and 27) and of NEFCO-2 project «Implementation of Energy Saving in Rivne Educational Establishment» (school No. 26)

The project «Investments in energy efficiency of public facilities and street lighting in Rivne» was implemented in the amount of EUR 1.2 million (by the NUEE fund).

As part of the project, thermal modernization was implemented in three preschool education institutions (Kindergarten No. 46, No. 33, No. 14) and individual heating points were installed in 8 institutions of the communal sphere of the Rivne City Territorial Community

The project «Reconstruction and restoration of the municipal infrastructure of Rivne city to support the urgent needs for internally displaced persons» in the amount of EUR 1.56 million is being implemented. Within the framework of the project, comprehensive thermal renovation of three buildings is being implemented in order to improve the living conditions of children with special needs, including children of displaced persons.

The project is implemented with the financial support of the European Union, with the participation of NEFCO, as an executive organization, within the framework of the NIP Program «EU Support to Urgent Housing Needs for Internally Displaced Persons in Ukraine»

The city of Rivne is implementing two infrastructure projects under the Interreg NEXT 2021–2027 Programme with a total value of over EUR 1.6 million:

- "Development of Sewerage Infrastructure and Improvement of Wastewater Management in Rivne and Lublin" (project cost EUR 1.36 million). The project involves the construction of a stormwater and meltwater drainage system along Chornovola, Drahomanova, and Zamkova streets, as well as the installation of complex separator systems that will allow treated water to be directed into the city's aquatic ecosystem.
- "Fire-Resistant and Waterproof: Cooperation of Civil Protection Services of Lublin and Rivne" (project cost EUR 281.0 thousand). As part of the project, 100 new above-ground fire hydrants will be installed, significantly reducing the response time of fire and rescue services and enhancing public safety, particularly in the event of potential emergencies





The project "The Missing Link in Ensuring Building Energy Efficiency," implemented under the LIFE Programme, is carried out with financial support from the European Climate, Infrastructure, and Environment Executive Agency (CINEA). The project cost amounts to EUR 622.1 thousand



The expected results of the project are:

- creation and operation of a permanent
 Energy Efficiency Office in the city of Rivne;
- implementation of at least 30 thermal modernization projects in multi-apartment buildings;
- annual increase in the number of energy efficiency projects by 10, based on a baseline of 10 projects per year;
- attraction of investments for energy efficiency measures totaling at least EUR 3.52 million;
- achievement of annual primary energy
 savings of 3.42 GWh

The project "Investments in Energy Efficiency of Budgetary Buildings and Street Lighting in Rivne," with a total value of EUR 3.6 million, is being implemented jointly with NEFCO. Within the project, works are being carried out on the full thermal modernization of educational institutions (Preschools No. 57 and No. 7); modernization of street lighting on 27 main streets, 118 secondary streets, and courtyard areas in the city of Rivne; and the installation of solar photovoltaic stations on the roofs of the surgical and therapeutic departments of the Rivne Central City Hospital

Implementation of the project «Creating a NetZero vision for the city of Rivne»

The city of Rivne is the only one among the cities of Ukraine to have received a grant and joined the fight against climate change within the framework of the NetZeroCities Pilot Cities Program - a two-year program funded by the European Union Mission.

Along with 52 other pilot cities such as Barcelona, Madrid, Rome, Amsterdam, Warsaw, Istanbul, Rivne is implementing innovative measures to improve adaptation to climate change and rapid decarbonization. The total cost of the project (grant funds under the Horizon 2020 program) is EUR 1.0 million

The main results of the project are:

- Aunique intelligent system for monitoring energy consumption in municipal buildings with online recording and remote data transmission, "PROFIT";
- 60 municipal institutions equipped with temperature loggers;
- 239 water and electricity meters in public buildings with automatic data transmission;
- Three scenarios modeled for the community's transition to zero CO2 emissions, including by 2050;
- Development of the NetZero Concept for the Rivne City Territorial Community by 2050;
- Creation of a demo center and a renewable energy laboratory at the National University of Water Management and Nature Resources

The Inclusivity Route has been opened in Rivne – the first inclusive route in Ukraine, developed within the framework of the national project "Movement Without Barriers." It is a 1.5 km barrier-free space on Symon Petliura Street that connects key city locations and will become part of a future 7.9 km route. The project was implemented through the cooperation of the city authorities and the charitable foundation "Ship of Help", including the installation of tactile paving, lowered curbs, renewed pavement, sensor terminals, and landscaping. The initiative makes the city more accessible for veterans, people with disabilities, and groups with limited mobility, drawing inspiration from the examples of European inclusive capitals



The project «Cultural heritage of the kitchen – promotion of culinary traditions through the professionalization of the gastronomic offer of Lublin and Rivne» was implemented as part of the Cross-Border Cooperation Program Poland-Belarus-Ukraine 2014-2020, European Neighborhood Instrument. The total cost of the project is EUR 65.8 thousand




